What We Are Learning

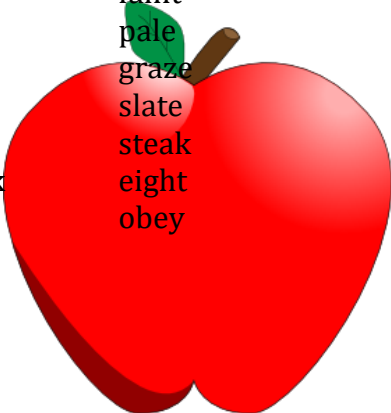
- Reading – Making Predictions, sequencing, Fairy Tales, Synonyms and Antonyms
